Tisk Tisk, You're High Caries Risk November 1, 2016

CAMBRA (CAries Management By Risk Assessment) is a simple concept to understand, but challenging to implement in routine practice, especially when patient compliance is just one of the obstacles. A proper caries risk assessment should be motivational, but yet procedure codes with terminology like "counseling" and "instruction" conjure up the notion of criticism and shame. Using data to track health and "not-so-healthy" outcomes can improve success by providing (almost) real time data, and empower your team to improve clinical effectiveness. A systematic risk assessment, and evidence based therapies along with effective measurement tools, can transform your dental practice into an oral healthcare office.

- 3. "WATER" lesions rather than "Watch" lesions
