

Hands-on Review of Local Anesthesia Techniques

If you are a Registered Dental Hygienist with a valid, current state permit/license to administer Local Anesthesia and would like to have faculty oversee your technique, this class is for you. We will review maxillary and mandibular nerve blocks. Specific injection techniques will be determined by participants. The goal of this course is to become more comfortable with injection techniques that you have already learned, or to troubleshoot any barriers you have encountered. This course includes four hours clinical and a two-hour lecture. Participants are required to sit as a patient. Required Forms: In order to participate you must have your permit/license to administer local anesthesia from your state dental board and sit as a patient for this hands-on course.

Please submit the following forms/copies to the Community Education and Training Department at MCC: state RDH license, CPR certification, state permit to Administer Local Anesthetic, medical history form, and consent form. Memo of Understanding is not required. Liability insurance covered by MCC. Note: If you have passed a local anesthesia certification course between October 2015 to the present, you may also participate in this class with proof of passed L/A certification course.
