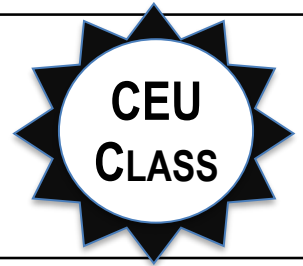




Local Anesthesia Refresher Clinical and Lecture



Local Anesthesia Refresher Course: Hands-On Review

If you are a RDH with a state license to administer local anesthesia and would like to have faculty oversee your technique, this class is for you. We will review maxillary and mandibular nerve blocks. Specific injection techniques will be determined by participants. The goal of this course is to become more comfortable with injection techniques that you have already learned, or to troubleshoot any barriers you have encountered. This course will include four hours clinical practice and a two hour lecture.

Required Forms: In order to participate you must have your state permit license to administer local anesthesia and sit as a patient for this hands-on course. Note: If you have passed a local anesthesia course between September 13, 2018 – present, you may enroll with proof of successful completion of your certification course.

Enroll and submit the following forms/copies: current/valid RDH license, CPR certification, Permit L or state license to administer Local Anesthesia, medical history forms and consent form. MCC's memo of understanding is not required for this course. (6 hours, 10 CEU's).
